Kirsten Buhl Møller trained at the Royal Danish Academy of Music, the soloist class and the Opera Academy with further studies in London and New York. She is professor and head of the vocal department at the Royal Danish Academy of Music.

Kirsten Buhl Møller has had an extensive career as an opera singer and concert performer in Denmark and abroad with a comprehensive repertoire and frequent appearances in radio and

television as well as recordings. Parallel to her teaching at the Academy of Music and the Opera Academy Kirsten Buhl Møller gives master classes and works with professional singers.

THE VOICE DEPARTMENT

The voice department at the Royal Danish Academy of Music is internationally renowned, primarily because of its many, outstanding graduates. The teaching staff is equally renowned, and is highly specialized within a wide variety of genres. All of the teachers are, or have been, active performers nationally as well as internationally.

The study programme aims to develop the student's skills in order to become a professional singer, whether as a soloist, choral singer and/or teacher. The tuition is individually compiled on the basis of the student's particular talent, artistic expression and personal profile. All students participate on an ongoing basis in concerts, drama projects, group lessons and master classes. The voice department collaborates with several outstanding musical institutions in Copenhagen and the vicinity in order to offer students the possibility of gaining professional work experience during their final years of study.

The Royal Danish Academy of Music (DKDM) is located in newly-renovated buildings in the heart of Copenhagen.

DKDM is Denmark's oldest and largest music academy specializing in classical music. DKDM offers a three-year bachelor programme, a two-year master's programme, and advanced postgraduate diploma programmes lasting from two to four years. All of the study programmes are designed to match the demands of a modern labour market for musicians and music teachers. The majority of the courses are aimed at performance at the highest level.

The Academy ascribes great importance to co-operation with the professional international music world, and students are trained by a large staff with the best professors and teachers from Denmark and abroad.
