Athanasia Kotronia: DJUPA KÄRLEK INGEN (Deep Love No one)

I first happened to read Ann Jäderlunds poetry collection ‘Djupa kärlek ingen’ when I was in my last year of highschool. When I wrote to Ann that I would really like to make the collection into music and asked for her permission she was happy to let me. Then I got worried so I wrote that I actually had no experience in working with modern poetry. Then she emailed me back;

”It’s easy to get already solidified forms, if you know, I think
And that in all creation one should hardly know?”

The songs you will hear in the song cycle are “Idén om att bli sann i kärleken”, “Okänd”, “Ängskovall”, “Djupa Kärlek” and “Synen”. The Song Cycle is containing texts from a fourth of the original collection.

Gustav Bjerre: Mondōka

Mondōka” is an ancient Japanese poem form, meaning ”dialogue poem”. The music is centred around a hazy, dream-like state, and at one point an intimate, timeless space suddenly appears in an almost naively simple and clear way that somehow frames the core of the piece.

Jean Thorel

Den franske dirigent Jean Thorel er en passioneret fortolker af ny og ukendt musik og har stået i spidsen for over 700 uropførelser. Han bliver regelmæssigt inviteret til større ny musik-festivaler, bl.a. Ars Musica Brussels, Numus Festival Aarhus, Musicorama i Hong Kong. Fra 2008 til 2016 var Jean Thorel chefdirigent ved City Chamber Orchestra of Hong Kong. Som gæstedirigent har han stået for utallige koncerter og indspilninger med bl.a. Ensemble Storstrøm, Aarhus Symfoniorkester, Musica Vitae, Sverige, Ensemble Quartz, Musiques Nouvelles, So Percussion Washington samt en række internationale orkestre, bl.a. The Royal Philharmonic London, National Symphony Orchestra of Ireland, Den Kgl. Ballet, Marseilles Philharmonic Orchestra og National Music Light Orchestra of Shanghai.
