According to the current <u>Executive Order on collection of payment from international students participating in the Danish Ministry of Culture's higher education programmes</u> of 14 Januar 2016:

Please note that the content of the Executive Order may be subject to changes.

The institutions shall charge full tuition fees for international students participating in full-time and part-time education programmes unless the student:

- has been granted a permanent residence permit or a temporary residence permit with the possibility of permanent residence in Denmark,
- has been exchanged with a Danish student according to an agreement between the institution and an institution abroad, or is a guest student at the institution as arranged through Fulbright or Denmark's International Study Program (DIS),
- has a right under Community law, including the EEA Agreement, or international agreements, including cultural agreements, entered into by Denmark to be treated on a par with Danish citizens, or
- has a residence permit pursuant to the Danish Aliens Act section 9c as accompanying child of a Non-EU/EEA parent holding a residence permit based on employment pursuant to <u>the Danish</u> Aliens Act section 9a.



NOTE: Applicants who expect to be exempted from paying tuition fee must apply on the same terms as EU/EEA applicants and before the specific application deadline.

Tuition fee-paying students are accepted on the basis of their citizenship status notified on the application date.

It is the applicant's own responsibility to inform RDAM of their correct residency status and to meet the current requirements and conditions regarding residence permit in Denmark.
